A. General Terms and Conditions:

1. Procedure for submission:

The sealed envelope super scribed as ***"TENDER FOR GROUP PERSONAL ACCIDENT INSURANCE POLICY (GPA) (WORKMEN & EMPLOYEE) & WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE POLICY (WC) FOR THE YEAR 2023-24"*** should be reached at the office of the SVNIT within the due date and time. Those who send the Bid documents by post, must ensure that the documents reach before the prescribed time and date. The Institute will not take any responsibility under any circumstances for courier/postal delays.

- 2. One authorized representative of the bidder can be present while opening the Bid with valid authorized letter and ID proof.
- 3. The Insurance Company should be registered with IRDAI.
- 4. The Insurance Company should have adequate experience as mentioned in the Technical Bid (Annexure-I) for providing such Insurance to Government/Semi-Government/Govt. of India Undertaking/ Autonomous Body/ Private Organization during the preceding **three years**. **A list of clients in proof of the above along with the copy of policy issued for such clients shall be furnished along with the technical bid, non-submission of the same will lead to rejection of the bid.**
- 5. The bidder should sign on each page of the Bid documents and submit the same along with the technical bid as part of technical bid document.
- 6. Bids which are late/vague/conditional/incomplete/not confirming to the laid down procedure in any respect will be rejected.
- 7. Bids sent by fax & e-mail will not be considered.
- 8. The successful Company shall at its own cost comply with the provision of orders and notifications issued by IRDAI and Government from time to time.
- 9. In case of failure in settlement of claims within the time frame, the penalty will be enforced as per Institute norms.



10. The Court of Surat alone will have the jurisdiction to try any matter, dispute or reference between the bidders and the Insurance Company arising out of this service. It is specifically agreed that no court outside and other than Court in Surat shall have jurisdiction in the matter.
11. **Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology (SVNIT)** reserves the right to modify/change/delete/add any further terms and conditions prior to issue of agreement.
12. **Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology (SVNIT)** reserves the right to accept or reject any or all proposals without assigning any reason. No tenderer shall have any cause of action or claim against **Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology (SVNIT)** for rejection of his/her proposal.
13. Canvassing in any form in connection with the tender is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the bidders who resort to canvassing are liable to be rejected.
14. In case, two or more responsive bidders have quoted the same price, which is also the lowest one rate offered, then Letter of acceptance (LOA)/ Work order shall be issued to insurance company whose settlement ratio is higher.
15. A Letter of Acceptance/ Work order will be given to the successful bidder, along with the cheque to the successful bidder and the same shall be treated as receives unconditional binding document on the part of the insurer till a formal insurance policy is issued.
16. Cancellation of Letter of acceptance/ Work order: - After issuance of the Letter of Acceptance, in case, the successful bidder fails to submit the executed Insurance Policy within 15 Days from the date of issue of LOA, for whatsoever reasons, as per terms & conditions of Bid then the LOA shall be cancelled by the SVNIT, in such case selected insurance company has to refund the full premium amount without any deduction and honor the loss occurred if any, as per the terms and condition of the LOA as per agreed terms and condition of the bid document.
17. All tenderers are hereby cautioned that conditional offers with deviations from the conditions and other requirements stipulated in these documents are likely to be rejected as non-responsive and will not be considered in tender evaluation and award of contract.
18. No correspondence will be entertained by SVNIT from the unsuccessful bidders.
19. The selected insurance company needs to issue an Invoice to facilitate issuance of Letter of Acceptance/ work order as per agreed terms as proposed in the bid document.
20. SVNIT and insurance company may extend the said contract with mutual consent.
21. **Bid Evaluation Criteria will be as follows.**

Stage 1: -	Companies qualifying the Technical Bid will only be eligible for price bid evaluation.
Stage 2: -	The entire price bid format to be filled by insurance company, not a single field should be left blank; total of all would be made to derive L1.
State 3: -	Once L1 is derived, will be informed to the concerned for ready reference with LOA/ work order.
22. Bid validity: 90 days.
23. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) is waived off.
24. The number of employees and total sum insured is given as on 31st October, 2023. This shall form the basis for paying the initial premium to the successful bidder. Renewed data will be shared subsequently with the successful bidder on issue of LOA/Work order. Difference in premium, if any, between provisional and actual renewed data shall be adjusted with the initial deposit.



25. There would be employees joining/ resigning/ retiring/ promoting/ demoting during the policy year. Intimation shall be made by 30th of the subsequent month. Initiation/ modification/ discontinuation of cover shall be from the effective dates as mentioned in such intimations. Premium shall be adjusted accordingly from/to the deposit maintained with the successful bidder in this regard.
26. All rates quoted shall be firm and shall remain unchanged for the period of validity of insurance.
27. Submission of authentic documents is the prime responsibility of the bidder. Wherever SVNIT has concern or apprehension regarding the authenticity/ correctness of any document, SVNIT reserves the right to get the documents verified from issuing authority/ any relevant source. If documents (part or full) are found forged, such offers will be summarily rejected and may be debarred from future tenders.
28. The insurer herewith understands that there will be no liability of SVNIT to make any kind of payment over and above the premium quoted by it, in any form, whether, by way of reimbursement of any kind of penalty imposed by any competent authority on insurer or any kind of differential of premium or any other form of payment, whatsoever it may be, whether imposed on insurer by any court of law or by any other authority.
29. The insurer herewith understands and agrees to the condition that, in case during concurrence of this insurance cover it is discovered that, the insurance premium charged or the terms of contract of insurance (policy) by the insurer/ underwriter, was inappropriate or was in violation of any statute, regulation or any guideline issued by any regulatory authority in this regard, it shall neither hamper coverage of the risk insured to us nor shall it result in any financial implication to SVNIT and in case of any financial implication, whether in form of penalty or otherwise and, consequential or otherwise, to SVNIT, the same shall be reimbursed in monetary terms to SVNIT.
30. Successful tenderer has to provide details of persons to be contacted in case of emergency along with their address, phone (mobile and land-line), fax number/s.
31. SVNIT will be allowed a period of 30 days from the date of commencement of the policy to review the terms and conditions of the policy and to return the same if not acceptable. If no claim is made during the free look period, SVNIT shall be entitled for the refund of premium paid.
32. If any breach is committed by the Insurer in delivery of the services stipulated herein or in the due performance or observance of the provisions of the Letter of Acceptance (LOA)/ Work Order, SVNIT shall be at liberty to terminate thereafter the Letter of Acceptance (LOA)/ Work Order by giving the Insurer thirty days' notice in writing and upon the expiry of the period of such notice, the Letter of Acceptance (LOA)/ Work Order shall stand terminated.

C. Indemnity against all actions of Insurer:

The Insurer shall hold and save harmless and indemnify the **Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology (SVNIT)**, from and against all actions, suits, proceedings, loss, costs, damages, charges, claims and demands of



every nature and description brought or recovered against the **Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology (SVNIT)** by reason of any act or omissions of the Insurer or his employees, in the execution of the Insurance or in the guarding of the same.

All sums payable by way of compensation under any of these conditions shall be considered as reasonable compensation payable to the Employer, without reference to the actual loss or damage sustained, and whether or not any damage shall have been sustained.

D. Correction of arithmetic errors

Provided that Financial Bid is substantially responsive, the Procuring Entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of Financial Bids on the following basis, namely: -

- (a) If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of SVNIT there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected.
- (b) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and
- (c) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (a) and (b) above.
- (d) If the Bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated Bid does not accept the correction of errors, its Bid shall be disqualified.

E. General responsibility of the Insurer:

The Insurer shall comply with the provisions of the insurance and with due care and diligence execute and maintain the insurance Plans and documents whether of temporary or permanent nature required for such execution and maintenance in so far as necessary for providing these, as is specified, or as is reasonably inferred from the Contract. I. Arbitration: -

Following standard Arbitration Clause shall become operative post award of contract to the successful Insurer insurance company.

Any question, dispute or difference whatsoever arises between SVNIT and Insurer/insurance company, in connection with this agreement except as to matters, the decision for which has been specifically provided, either party may forthwith give to the other notice in writing of existence of such questions, dispute, difference and the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of a person nominated by the Director of SVNIT. This reference shall be governed by Indian Arbitration Act prevailing at the time of dispute and the rules made there under. The award in such arbitration shall be final and binding on all the parties. Work under the agreement shall continue during the arbitration proceedings unless the SVNIT or the Arbitrator directs otherwise.
