INITIATIVE FRAMEWORK

Program Objective

Enable high-performing NIT students to complete their final BTech year at IITB and seamlessly transition to MTech/PhD programs.

Academic Structure

6th Sem Nomination → 1-Year Visiting Exchange (7th and 8th sem) → B.Tech Completion → Direct Entry into M.Tech / Ph.D. (GATE Exempt).

Governance

Rigorous department-level review process with specific quotas defined in formal MoUs with partner NITs.

Capacity & Allocation

Intake is initially capped at 20% of the total MTech Teaching Assistantship and up to 5 seats per NIT for each department.

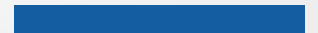

Hostel Eligibility

Teaching assistantship (TA)

MOE, GOI

The assistantship is payable for a maximum duration of 5 years or up to the thesis submission, whichever is earlier. The monthly rate of assistantship is Rs. 37,000/- for the first 2 years and enhanced rate of Rs. 42,000/- for the remaining period.

The continuation of assistantship under TA category will be subject to serving as a teaching assistant in a course / laboratory for 8 hours per week as assigned by the concerned academic unit as well as satisfactory academic performance.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates must maintain a **minimum CGPA of 8.0** at the time of nomination. A consistent record of academic excellence and strong standing within their home NIT department is mandatory.

Students must maintain a minimum **CGPA of 7.0** at IIT Bombay during their 7th semester. **Failure to meet** this requirement may result in **discontinuation from the programme**, and the student will exit with a B.Tech. degree from the respective NIT only.

Students shall register for and complete courses offered at IIT Bombay to fulfil the credit requirements of the B.Tech. degree, as identified and approved by the respective departments of the concerned NIT. The responsibility for credit transfer and certification of credits earned at IIT Bombay shall rest solely with IIT Bombay.
