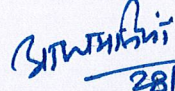

- (vi) ITR Form (1-2-3-4-5-6-7 form) as applicable of Assessment Year 2026-2027 (Financial Year 2025-2026)
- (vii) Fee Refund Form (Form No. 2) with fee receipt and photocopy of bank passbook/cancelled cheque
