Tech.-1<sup>st</sup> Year (Autumn Semester of Academic Year 2026-27) programme of Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology Surat will be held as per given schedule available on the Institute website. **Candidates are requested to check the Institute website ([www.svnit.ac.in](http://www.svnit.ac.in)) regularly for any modification/update.**

### Important Instructions:

- 1) Written Test will be conducted only for Non-GATE Candidates meeting eligibility criteria.
- 2) Candidates admitted and allotted SVNIT Surat through CCMT-2026 are also eligible for Internal Sliding within the department. Such candidate has to do registration by paying the Institute Spot Round application fee.
- 3) Candidates with valid GATE score (of year 2024/2025/2026) are preferred and eligible for counselling based on GATE Score only.
- 4) Candidates are required to regularly visit the Institute website for updates, possible modifications if any.
- 5) **The Institute Spot Round for a given program will be operated only for those seats which remain vacant in CCMT-2026 rounds. It will not be operated for those programs whose all seats are filled through CCMT-2026, even if registration is done for Institute Spot Round and registration fees will not be refunded.**
- 6) If number of Vacant Seats exceeds number of registered/reported candidates with valid GATE score (of year 2024/2025/2026), the merit list for Non-GATE candidates will be operated.
- 7) For any discrepancy, details given through CCMT-2026 and academic regulation (2023-24 onwards) will only be considered.

### 1. Eligibility

**For Non-GATE Candidates:** The candidate should have passed B.E. /B. Tech. / B. Arch. / B. Plan. in an appropriate branch from an approved Institute/University with minimum 60% marks (or CGPA 6.5/10) for GEN/GEN- EWS/OBC and 55% marks (or CGPA 6.0/ 10) for SC/ ST/ PwD. Conversion

from CGPA to percentage or vice versa given by individual Institute/University will not be considered/allowed.

**For GATE Candidates:** Admission to M. Tech. programmes through Institute Spot Round admission at SVNIT, Surat will be as per the CCMT-2026 eligibility norms. The eligibility conditions for the M. Tech. programmes are given below as per CCMT 2026 information Brochure.

A candidate to be eligible for M.Tech./M.Arch./M.Plan. programme:

- i. Must have a valid GATE score of the year 2024 / 2025 / 2026.
- ii. In qualifying degree, the candidates should have passed and secured at least **6.5 CGPA (on a 10- point scale) or 60% for GEN/GEN-EWS/OBC, whereas 6.0 CGPA (on a 10-point scale) or 55% in case of SC/ST/PwD candidates.** The above mentioned CGPA/Percentage should be awarded by a recognized University/Institute. Only primary mode of evaluation (CGPA or percentage) as mentioned in the qualifying degree certificate/mark sheet shall be considered while verifying eligibility. In case both CGPA and percentage are mentioned, then only CGPA would be considered. Conversion from CGPA to percentage or vice versa given by an individual Institute/university will not be allowed. Please refer to CCMT 2026 information Brochure for further details.

For GATE qualified candidates, the eligible Qualifying Degree and GATE papers matrix will be as per CCMT-2026, (please refer:

<https://admissions.nic.in/CCMT/Applicant/Report/SeatMapping.aspx?boardid=105012621>), which will be considered for a given M Tech Program under Institute Spot Round admission.

## **2. Registration for Institute Spot Round Admission**

The eligible candidates (GATE and NON-GATE) should register for Institute Spot Round admission through the following link by paying a **non-refundable registration fee of Rs.500/- (for the GENERAL/OBC-NCL/EWS category) and Rs. 250/- (For the SC/ST/PwD category).**

Registration and application fee payment has to be made through link given below. Candidates allotted M.Tech. Programme in SVNIT, Surat and admitted through CCMT-2026 are required to do registration and pay application fees to participate in the **Institute Spot Round.**

## **3. Selection Procedure**

Vacant Seat under a given category will be allotted to registered/reported candidate with valid GATE

Score (2024/2025/2026) meeting other eligible criteria's. If number of vacant seats are more than registered/reported GATE candidates, merit list of Non-GATE candidates would be operated. The syllabus of the question paper of the written test conducted by the specific Department would be the syllabus of the GATE paper of the B.Tech. programme offered by the Department.

### Merit List Preparation

#### (a) Candidate with valid GATE score

Merit for seat allotment in the **ISR** will be prepared based on valid GATE score of the year filled by the candidate. In case of same GATE score, to resolve and to determine merit of candidates, the following criteria will be used in the stated order.

1. Candidates having GATE score in 2024 will be given preference over candidates having score of 2025, or 2026.
2. Candidates having GATE score in 2025 will be given preference over candidates having score of 2026.
3. If year of GATE score is same, then preference will be given to that candidate who has obtained better GATE marks out of 100.
4. In the unlikely event of their year of GATE score and GATE marks out of 100 being the same, preference will be given based on the All-India Rank (AIR).
5. In highly unlikely even to candidates having same year of GATE score, GATE marks out of 100, and AIR, Date of Birth will be considered. Elder candidate will be given preference.

#### (b) Candidate without GATE score (Non-GATE)

Merit for seat allotment in the **ISR** will be prepared based on 50% weightage to aggregate marks of B.E./B.Tech./equivalent degree and 50% weightage to Institute's written test/interview. Following the vacancy arising from GATE candidates, the **'written test' of the duration of one-hour would be conducted for non-GATE candidates. The number of questions (MCQs) in the written test is fifty.** The syllabus of the question paper of the written test conducted by the specific Department would be the syllabus of the GATE paper of the B.Tech. programme offered by the Department.

The merit list will be prepared by giving 50% weightage to aggregate marks of B.E./B.Tech./equivalent degree and 50% weightage to Institute's test/interview for all candidates who have applied and qualified for that particular discipline.

After preparing the merit list based on above criteria, in case of similar score obtained by candidates, to resolve and determine inter-se-merit of candidates, following criteria will be used in the stated order.

1. Candidates having higher percentage/CGPA in qualifying degree will be given preference.
2. Candidates having same percentage/CGPA in qualifying degree, Date of Birth will be considered. Elder candidate will be given preference.

#### **4. Instructions for Document Uploading**

After registration and application fee payment the candidates have to upload the documents as per the list given, through the Institute website using the link as given below.

##### **(a) List of Documents to be Uploaded in the Institute Portal**

Candidates are required to upload the coloured scanned copy of the following original Documents:

- (i) Aadhaar Card/Any other Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.
- (ii) **GATE Score Card (2024/2025/2026) for M.Tech (Not applicable for non-GATE candidate).**
- (iii) Class X<sup>th</sup> mark-sheet as proof of date of birth.
- (iv) Mark Sheet of class XII
- (v) Grade/Mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters (Mark sheets of all semesters need to be combined to a single pdf for uploading/ Consolidated Grade (Mark) sheet with all subjects mentioned in it).

- (vi) Degree/Provisional Degree Certificate. If result of qualifying degree is awaited, certificate of course completion from the institute/university last studied must be provided in the prescribed format available in **Annexure-A**.
- (vii) Certificate for Economically Weaker Sections, if applicable, issued by the competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar or mamlatdar) indicating the financial status for the financial year ending March 31, 2026 (2025-26) **(should have been issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2026)**.
- (viii) Community Certificate, in the case of OBC candidate, if applicable, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar or Mamlatdar) indicating the status regarding Creamy Layer based on financial year ending March 31, 2026 **(should have been issued on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2026)**.
- (ix) Community Certificate, in the case of SC/ST candidate, from a competent authority (not below the rank of Tahsildar or Mamlatdar). For certificate format of SC/ST, refer following link
- (x) Certificate from the Medical Board of Govt. Medical Colleges/District Head Quarters Hospitals, in the case of Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable.
- (xi) For certificate format of EWS/OBC-NCL/SC/ST refer following link

- (xii) One passport size photograph

**Notes:**

- (i) Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate. ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer. If the original certificates are not in English/Hindi, English/Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority of the graduating Institute, will be required for verification of documents.
- (ii) All the documents are to be scanned fully till the end, making sure that all the details and signatures of the authority are clearly visible.
- (iii) Candidates who are appearing for their final examination and are awaiting results should produce the original mark list of final semester/year and the degree certificate/provisional certificate (satisfying the eligibility criteria) by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2026. They

have to produce a certificate from the Head of the Institution stating that he/she has appeared/appearing for the final semester/ year examination of the qualifying degree in the prescribed form as given in **Annexure-A**. The candidates also have to submit an undertaking in the prescribed form as given in **Annexure-B**.

- (iv) The candidate shall use **Annexure C** as undertaking for late submission of relevant documents like degree certificate, final year result etc. Such undertaking shall not be admissible for Category related Certificates. In absence of relevant category certificates/documents the candidate claimed category will be changed to New Category as given below.

### (b) Physical Reporting

All eligible students of the Institute Spot Round (ISR), have to report physically on the date of written test at 9.00 a.m. in the respective Engineering Department. The candidates are required to regularly visit the institute website for updates. Based on the candidates who are present during the spot round admission, the allotment of the vacant seats will be done and announced as per procedure. The candidates who got provisional admission in Institute Spot Round will have to do academic registration and pay fees. The schedule of the physical document verification, candidates allotted seat in Institute Spot Round, will be as per schedule.

## 5. Infrastructure and Facilities

**Hostel:** Sardar Vallabhbhai National Institute of Technology (SVNIT) Surat is residential institute and Hostel section of the institute is established to deal with all the matters related to accommodation, food and general wellbeing of the students. Presently, the Institute Campus has 09 hostels which include 07 boys' hostels and 02 girls' hostels. The activities of hostels are managed by the Council of Wardens (CoW) and Hostel Management Committees (HMC) of the students. Council of Warden includes the Chief Warden and Wardens of the

hostels with Co-Chairman as the Associate Dean (Students Welfare) and Chairman as Dean (Students Welfare). All the hostels are equipped with basic facilities like furniture, WiFi/LAN enabled internet, Mess, and recreational facilities like fully equipped sports facilities, music rooms, magazine rooms and television rooms. Most hostel-level meetings take place in common rooms.

All on-roll students are covered under the Medical Insurance scheme for inpatient treatment. The insurance covers hospitalization expenses of up to Rs. 50,000/-. Students get cover with cashless hospitalization facilities in-network hospitals of Insurance companies.

**Computing, Internet and Intranet:** The Central Computer Centre (CCC) primarily caters to the Internet Access requirements throughout the institute and Campus-wide network connectivity throughout the campus, including academic & administration departments, hostels, staff quarters, guest house etc. For further details refer <https://www.svnit.ac.in/web/ccc.php>

**Sports/Indoor Games and Gym:** Student Activities Center (SAC) of the institute organizes and manages sports, co-curricular and extracurricular activities of students and staffs. It has adequate sport facilities like Badminton courts with standard size of synthetic flooring, proper light and ventilation, two International standard synthetic Tennis courts with class-3 flood lights and modern seating arrangement for the spectators, two Volleyball grounds with standard quality grounds with flood lights, two Basketball courts facility with standard size of concrete flooring, proper light, Pool Table, Table Tennis and football ground. In addition to above, the institute has a Gymnasium Hall equipped with varieties of equipment's i.e more than 15 stations for specific body part exercise. Further, the SAC provides coaching camps for various games like Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Handball, KhoKho, Kabaddi, Swimming and Yoga etc.

**Career Development Cell (CDC):** Institute has full-fledged Training & Placement Section (T&P) under the Professor In-charge Training & Placemat. It helps the student's community to get the proper placement in various public and private sector organizations by arranging the campus interviews. The placement of final year students starts at the beginning of the academic year. Further, to strengthen the Industry-Institute interaction, CDC section encourages the companies for an internship to B. Tech. 3<sup>rd</sup> year students (maximum 8 weeks in summer vacation) and to M. Tech. students (maximum 1 year) in their 2<sup>nd</sup> year as a dissertation work. **Industry and Alumni Relations:** The institute is having its alumni association, which takes an active interest in the growth of the institute. The institute has signed several MoUs with

industries such as Reliance, L&T, Essar, Altair, Patni and various Technical Institutions and, Universities in India and abroad. The SVNIT Surat is having wide network of its alumni across the globe. The alumni of the institute are placed at the high rank in the government, semi-government and private institutions serving the country whole heartedly. The networking of students with alumni be carried out through the office of Dean (Alumni and Resources Generation) and office SVNIT Surat Alumni Association situated within the campus of the institute. The networking of the SVNIT Surat Alumni is through Alma Connect. The alumni of institute support the various academic, research, sports and placement activities of the institute apart from financially helping the needy students. The alumni association organizes the annual convention of alumni of institute every year which is one of the most awaited events.

**Recreational/Extra Curricular activities:** Apart from academics, the institute takes due care of the overall development of students through extracurricular activities like “KASHISH” the welcome program for first-year students. A three-day cultural event “SPARSH” is one of the most cherished activities of the students. A technical event like “MINDBEND” along with activities of various student chapters/clubs such as Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), Centre for Humanity Resource Development (CHRD), Chemical Engineering Society (CHES), Civil Engineering Society (CES), Cutting Edge Visionaries (CEV), DRISHTI, Electrical Engineering Society (EES), Indian Institute of Welding (IIW), Indian Institution of Industrial Engineering (IIIE), Indian Society for Technical Education Society (ISTE), Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE), Institution of Engineers (IE), Literary Affairs Committee (LAC), NIRVANA- a programme of social engineering, RENESA, Society for Cultivation of Science & Humanities (SCOSH), Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE), SPIC-MACAY (Society for the Promotion of Indian Classical Music And Culture Amongst Youth), The Institution of Electronics & Telecommunication Engineers (IETE) etc. are organized throughout a year to keep a student involved in co-curricular activities.

**Central library:** The institute has a library of world-class standards with an area of 17070 square meters. The library maintains various Databases and Standards (Online) like IEEE/IET Electronic Library, McGraw Hill Access Engineering Online Database, ASME Standards (Except BPVC), Indian Standards, International Electro-Technical Commission (IEC) Standards, ASTM Standards, American Welding Society Standards, etc. The institute subscribes to several research support tools, including Turnitin (plagiarism detection online software), Grammarly Premium, SCOPUS Database, SciFinder-n, and Web of Science Lease Access. Central Library also subscribes to the GATE preparation platform for all Engineering

disciplines. The Central Library is a member of e-Sodh Sindhu: Consortia for Higher Education E-Resources. The library is also a member of the Developing Library Network (DELNET), New Delhi.

**Health Centre:** The Health Centre of SVNIT is established to ensure adequate & qualitative healthcare facilities for all the students, faculties, and staff with their family members at SVNIT. The Health Centre is managed by full-time residential doctor and Medical Officers on a contractual basis.

**Location and Accessibility** Surat is one of the central nodes on the Mumbai-Delhi (National Highway 48) and is connected to the country by Road, Rail, and Air. SVNIT, Surat is located in the city's prime area, locally known as Ichchhanath, at about 10 KMs from the Surat Railway Station. It is on the way to Dumas Sea beach from the railway station. The city buses regularly operate from early morning till midnight, between Surat Railway Station and Institute Campus/Piplod. Other than the city bus, auto-rickshaws (more commonly) or taxis are also available. Surat also has International Airport at Magdalla-Dumas Road, approximately 07 KM from the institute campus. The operating airlines connect Surat to Major Indian Cities e.g. Chennai, Bangalore, Bhubaneswar, Delhi, Hyderabad, Goa, Kolkata, Jaipur, Mumbai, and Patna.
