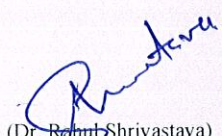

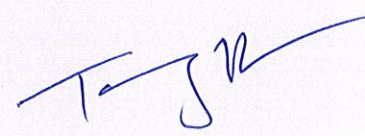
The schedule for the Ph.D. Admission for the Autumn Semester of the Academic Year 2026-27 (Phase-III) for the Department of Artificial Intelligence (DoAI) is as follows:

1. **Reporting Date & Time:** 9.00 am on July 21, 2026

2. **Document Verification:** 9:30 am to 11:00 am on July 21, 2026
 - a. **Venue:** DoAI007, Ground Floor of the Department of Artificial Intelligence
3. **Written Test (50 Marks):** 11:30 am to 12:30 pm on July 21, 2026
 - a. **Venue:** DoAI001, Ground Floor of the Department of Artificial Intelligence
4. **List of Qualified Candidates for Presentation & Interview:** 1:30 pm on July 21, 2026
 - a. **Venue:** Department Notice Board
5. **Presentation & Interview (50 Marks):** 2.00 pm onwards on July 21, 2026

Instructions for Candidates:

1. All (Eligible and Conditionally Eligible) candidates are required to be present for the document verification round on **21st July 2026, starting at 9:30 am to 11:00 am**, at the **Room No DoAI007, Department of Artificial Intelligence**.
2. All (Eligible and Conditionally Eligible) candidates must produce the required certificates in **ORIGINAL** as mentioned in the Institute's Ph.D. Application Portal during document verification; failure to do so will result in disqualification from the written test/interview.
3. All (Eligible and Conditionally Eligible) candidates must bring one set of clear **Self-Attested Photocopies** of the necessary documents as mentioned in the Institute's Ph.D. Application Portal.
4. Candidates belonging to the **OBC-NCL & EWS category** are required to produce the latest (valid) certificate as per the Central Government Format.
5. The written test will immediately follow the document verification.
6. The candidate's qualifying written test will have to give a presentation (of about 10-12 minutes) on the tentative topic in which he/she aspires to pursue his/her Ph.D. Program followed by an interview. **Presentation/Interview will be on the same day i.e. 21st July 2026.**
