The Department of Chemistry SVNIT is going to conduct walk-in-interview in offline mode (written test and interview) for the post of Teaching Assistants (purely on ad-hoc basis for 11 months) in the Department of Chemistry on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2022 (Reference: No. DoC/TAs/814/2022, dated 01.08.2022).

The minimum qualifications and remuneration to be paid to the Teaching Assistant(s) purely on ad-hoc basis for 11 months is as given below:

Sr. No	Eligible criteria	Remuneration
1	1 <sup>st</sup> Class or an equivalent GCPA (Min 6.5 on the scale of 10) in both M.Phil. and M.Sc in Chemistry with good academic record	Rs. 45,000/- per month
2	Ph.D in Chemistry with good academic record with first class or an equivalent GCPA (Min 6.5 on the scale of 10) in M.Sc (Chemistry)	Rs. 60,000/- per month

The candidates are requested to remain present with filled application in the prescribed form only, along with original supporting documents such as degree certificates, semester-wise mark sheets, experience certificates, testimonials, etc. and one set of self-attested copy of the same documents at 9.30 AM in the Department of Chemistry on 17<sup>th</sup> August 2022 (Wednesday).

Any wrong or misleading information supplied by the candidate may lead to summarily rejection of the application / appointment, if found subsequently.
