The aforesaid meeting was conducted on April 29, 2021, 12:30 pm onwards in the online mode. The following were present in the IAAC meeting:





Item and resolution:

Item 50(1)	To discuss and adopt the resolution about the possibility of limitations to be faced by the Examinees in the Spring Semester examination of the AY 2020-21. That are attributed to the COVID-19 reasons.
Res. 50(1)	<p>The following are resolved:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">(1) In case of any difficulty in writing the 'End semester regular examination' scheduled in the month of May, 2021, Students may 'opt' the Supplementary examination scheduled in the month of July 2021, i.e. an alternative to the 'End semester regular examination'. This option would be treated as a regular examination. The associated 'first' Supplementary examination for the students, opting this choice, is the Supplementary examination scheduled in the February month of the year 2022. This holds applicable to theory as well as practicals of 'End semester regular examination'. Apart from the above, Academic regulations hold applicable.(2) This 'option' is applicable to the following programs: (a) B Tech programs, excluding the first year, (b) MSc programs, excluding the first year (c) M Tech first year program (d) PhD first year program.(3) Students, opting to the above-mentioned alternative examination, are required to submit duly signed application to the respective Head of the Department for the completion of the Department-level procedure and then, transmitted onward to the Academic section. The application must reach to the Academic Section preferably before beginning of the examination. The Student would submit the authentic, substantiated COVID-19 test report. Here, the word 'report' pertains to self, or of the parents, or close relatives. <p>In addition to the above, Students facing uncertainty in internet resources during the examination may opt this arrangement (see (1) of the resolution) by informing to the concerned Course Coordinator/Head of the Department.</p> <p>Please refer to Resolution 49(1) (b) of the IAAC regarding the mode of examinations for the regular examination of the Spring Semester of the Academic year 2020-21.</p> <p>The above are recommended for the Senate ratification.</p>
