	passing semester will be given the consideration while deciding the					
	order of merit.					
	ii) In case, the Cumulative Earn grade points of passing semester are also					
	same for the students, then, the CGPA/ Cumulative Earn grade points of					
	the previous semesters in decreasing order of Semesters will be given					
	the priority. For example, in case the Cumulative Earn grade points of					
	VIII Sem are also same for the B Tech students, then, the CGPA/					
	Cumulative Earn grade points of the VII Semester will be considered for					
	deciding the merit. Similarly, in case the Cumulative Earn grade points of					
	VII Sem are also same for the B Tech students, then, the CGPA/					
	Cumulative Earn grade points of the VI Semester will be considered for					
	deciding the merit, and so on.
