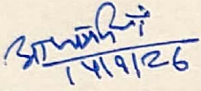

Reso. 27 (1)	The Committee considered the request of Mr. Pratik Suryawanshi (U20ME098), a student of B.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering), seeking permission to continue his studies in the Third Year on medical grounds, despite having exceeded the prescribed maximum duration of six years for completion of the B.Tech. program. After due consideration of the matter and the grounds stated in his request, the Committee approved the request as a special case on medical grounds and granted one-time relaxation, permitting the student to continue his studies in the Third Year. The Committee further resolved that no further relaxation shall be grants to the student in the future. The student shall be required to fulfill all the prescribed academic requirements, including the applicable credit/backlog requirements, as per the Institute rules and regulations for his further academic progression.

(Mechanical Engineering), seeking permission to continue his studies in the fourth year on medical grounds, despite having exceeded the prescribed maximum duration of seven years for completion of the B.Tech. program.



After due consideration of the matter based on the medical grounds and recommendation of the Head, Department of Mechanical Engineering, the Committee approved the request as a special case on medical grounds and granted one-time relaxation, permitting the student to continue his studies and complete the remaining academic requirements of the B.Tech. program.

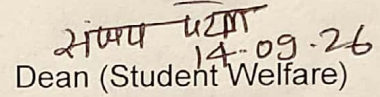

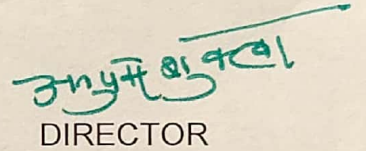
