Vaidya, Operations Management (Indian Institute of Management Lucknow, Lucknow) and Prof. Ravi Prakash Tewari, Department of Applied Mechanics (Motilal Nehru National Institute of Technology Allahabad, Prayagraj). The Students' representatives proposed to waive off the charges for the interdepartmental access to the resources of the Academic Departments of the Institute. The proposal was appreciated and the Senate allowed the Students of the Institute to access the interdepartmental facilities and resources of the Institute to meet their academic requirements on the non-payment basis from onwards. After deliberations on "a proposal of the Students' representatives for a rearrangement in the ongoing offline mode of the Autumn Semester teaching and concerning examinations of AY 2022-23", the Senate preserved the existing system to achieve the uniformity in the methods of teaching and evaluations of the Academic Programmes of the Institute.

Thereafter, the Dean (Academic) was requested to proceed with the agenda items.

Minutes of 55<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Senate held on September 20, 2022

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The recommendation is to bifurcate the existing 'Department of Mathematics and Humanities'. That would result in three Academic Departments, i.e. Department of Mathematics, 'Department of Humanities and Social Sciences' and School of Management. Regarding the Academic programmes and their national status, the ongoing programmes under the aegis of the Departments of Mathematics were consulted, e.g. <a href="https://maths.iitd.ac.in/drupal/Undergraduate2525">https://maths.iitd.ac.in/drupal/Undergraduate2525</a>, <a href="https://www.iitg.ac.in/maths/">https://www.iitg.ac.in/maths/</a>

The IAAC recommended that the Academic Programme associated with the Department of Mathematics of SVNIT would be 'Bachelor of Technology in Mathematics and Computing' (MaC) of the four-year duration. The objective of B.Tech, is to achieve the balance between the theoretical and computational aspects of Mathematics addressing the formidability of the tomorrow's challenges. This addition would create opportunities for the MaC graduate students with diversity, e.g. finance, analytics, consulting, cryptography-based security and information technology. It was decided to complete the design of the curriculum of the above<sub>1</sub> mentioned programme, including the requirements, by the end of December 2022. That would be enrouted via the Academic Bodies of the Institute. Regarding the Academic Programme within the School of Management (mentioned above), it was resolved to run a five-year integrated MBA programme with the blend of 'Information Technology and Management techniques. It was decided to complete the design of the curriculum of the abovementioned Management programme, including the requirements, by the end of December 2022. That would be enrouted via the Academic Bodies of the Institute. The Senate was requested to approve the same.

Res. 5 After contemplations, the Senate resolved and recommended demerger of the existing 'Department of Mathematics and Humanities' into three Departments, i.e. Department of Mathematics, Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, and Department of Management Studies.

In lieu of the introduction of B. Tech. in Mathematics and Computing, the Senate agreed for the introduction of Dual Degree Programme: Bachelor of Technology and Master of Technology in Mathematics and Computing 'with the Exit option' after meeting the total credit requirements for award of B.Tech. degree in Mathematics and Computing. The Dual Degree Programme in Mathematics and Computing (MaC) is primarily intended to produce post-graduate Students with strong foundations to apply their learning to solve the complex and the interconnected problems of the Industry, Society and to impart better services to the Nation. The Senate recommended the same for approval of BoG for demerger of Department and introduction of the abovementioned new 'Dual Degree Programme'.

Regarding introduction of a new MBA programme, decisions would be taken in due course of time.

#### Item from the Chair

Item 6 To ratify a 'recommendation' made in the 13<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing Executive Committee of the Senate held on August 8, 2022, 4:00 pm onwards.

The recommendation is to update and modify the curricula of two branches namely 'Computer Science and Engineering' and 'Electronics and Communication Engineering'. It was resolved to replace the Courses, i.e. Applied Chemistry, Engineering Drawing, Workshop Practice, "Mechanics, Laser and Fibre Optics", Engineering Mechanics, with greatly relevant Courses of the B. Tech. programme in Computer Science and Engineering. Further, it was resolved to replace 'Electrical Networks' with 'Basics of Electrical Engineering' and 'Physics of Materials and Nuclei' with an alternative course on Physics'.

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	The above 'modifications' stand applicable to the B.Tech. programme in Electronics and Communication Engineering as well. Notably, 'Basics of Electrical Engineering' is already included in the curriculum of the B.Tech. programme in Electronics and Communications Engineering.  The above modifications are made with the objective of achieving greater employability and resulting in focussed future research directions for concerning B. Tech. Students.
Res. 6	The Senate ratified the recommendation of the 13 <sup>th</sup> Standing Executive Committee for the adoption of the concerning revised curricula. The revised curriculum will be effective from academic year 2022-23. In addition, the Senate also resolved the following.
	(i) The Senate revised the terminologies for the type of the Courses of the Academic Programmes of the Institute. The Senate omitted the 'Core Elective terminology' from the Curriculum. 
