The SVNIT is mentoring Institute of IIIT Surat is getting overwhelming response in admission for AY 2017 – 18. The Chairperson also appreciated Prof. S. A. Channiwala for getting two high valued research project form DRDO, Govt of India.

The following business was transacted:

- Item 1: To confirm the minutes of 39th meeting of the Senate held on April 29, 2017.
- Res. 1: "Resolved that the minutes of the 39th meeting of the Senate held on April 29, 2017 be confirmed."
- Item 2: To note and approve the action taken on the resolution adopted at the 39th meeting of Senate held on April 29, 2017 in the Conference Room of the Institute Guest House.
- **Res. 2:** Resolved that resolutions adopted in the 39th meeting of Institute Senate held on April 29, 2017 be noted and approved. Further, following resolutions were taken with reference to Res. 3(a), (b) and Res. 4 of the meeting held on April 29, 2017
 - A) With reference to Res. 3(a), HOD Applied Physics Department is requested to submit the proposal for starting MSc (Physics) 2 years course by August 2017, including complete justification of faculty, staff and laboratory requirement for starting the programme.
 - B) With reference to Res. 3(b), the resolution of the committee forwarded vide letter No. Dean(Acad)/879/2016-17, dated 06/07/2017 to Institute Senate Chairperson was apprised to the august house wherein it is intimated that Shri D. B. Gohil, Associate Professor, Mechanical Engineering Department did not turn up before the committee on scheduled date (July 06, 2017) for



handing over the answer scripts of aggrieved students - Summer semester (May – July 2016).

It is resolved that

- i) Shri. D. B. Gohil, Associate Professor, MED be served notice by the Institute Director for submission of answer scripts of aggrieved students of Summer Semester (May-July 2016) to the committee constituted vide Res. 5(a) of 37th Institute Senate within 72 hours after the receipt of notice.
- ii) It is further resolved that in case Shri. D. B. Gohil, Associate Professor (MED) fails to submit the answer scripts within 72 hours after serving the notice, as above, the following course of action be initiated:-
 - The matter be referred to BoG by Institute Director for initiating suitable action against Shri. D. B. Gohil Associate Professor (MED) for repeatedly not complying the directives of Institute Senate.
 - ❖ Alternatively, all examinations for the subject ME 204 Mechatronics be conducted for aggrieved students, who have still not cleared the subject till Supplementary Examination, July 2017. Further, the Institute Director is empowered by the august house to appoint suitable faculty for above subject in setting of question paper, conducting examination, evaluation and submission of marks in the examination cell of the Institute.
- C) With reference to Res. 4, following Resolutions of 30th IAAC meeting were discussed in the meeting:
 - i) With reference to Res. 17.5 of 30th IAAC meeting, regarding 'Preventions of Plagiarism at the Institute level', was discussed at length including the 'Draft report' of the committee constitute vide 22nd IAAC meeting, Res. 48 held on April 28st 2015, and recommendations of the Committee constitute by 36th Institute Senate (Reso. 6).
