
INTRODUCTION



- Shri. Narendra Modi, the Prime Minister of India had launched the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) on 2nd October, 2014.
- The Mission Coordinator : Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Ministry of Jalshakti

1. INDIVIDUAL HOUSEHOLD LATRINES (I.H.H.L)

- The incentive amount provided under SBM(G) to Below Poverty Line (BPL) /identified APL households is up to Rs.12,000 for construction of one unit of IHHL.
- Step 1: Gram Panchayat send the list with application forms to Taluka Panchayat, and after that Taluka Panchayat fill the onlin form on website.
- Step 2: After sanctioning the grant from Central Government to Taluka Panchayat, work order releases to agency/beneficiary itself/ Gramya Sukhakari Karya Samiti (Available at every Gram).
- Step 3: After construction of IHHL, Taluka Panchayat submit the GEO TAG of constructed IHHL and sent to online data and after that amount Rs. 12,000 transfer (DBT) into beneficiaries' account.



2. COMMUNITY SANITARY COMPLEX (CSC)


- > The maximum support per unit prescribed for a Community Sanitary Complex is Rs.2 lakh.
- Step 1: Gram Panchayat apply for CSC to Taluka (Block) Panchayat and TP apply to SBM-Gramin District Office and after that application sent to State Committee and after all grant sanctioned to SBM-Gramin District Office.
- Step 2: After sanctioning the grant from Central Government to Taluka Panchayat, work order releases to agency/Gramya Sukhakari Karya Samiti (Available at every Gram).
- Step 3: After construction of CSC, Taluka Panchayat submit the GEO TAG of constructed CSC and sent to online data and after that amount Rs. 2,00,000 transfer (DBT) into GP account.

3. Solid and Liquid Waste Management

- Solid and Liquid Waste Management (SLWM) is one of the key components of the programme in creating clean villages.
- > Once the demand is created, SLWM is to be taken up in project mode for each Gram Panchayat (GP) within the financial cap.
- ▶ Funding for SLWM project under SBM(G) is provided by the Central and State Government in the ratio of 60:40.
- Any additional cost requirement is to be met by funds from the State/GP and from other sources like Finance Commission, CSR, Swachh Bharat Kosh and PPP model.

Solid & Liquid Water in Rural Area




Figure 3: Definition of Solid and Liquid waste in rural area

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF TECHNOLOGY

- > Availability of space near houses and housing pattern.
- Geophysical condition of the village including topography, soil structure and ground water conditions.
- Sources and pattern of water supply (individual / public).
- > Availability of common space in and around the village.
- > Economic status and human resources available with the GP.

- Step 3: Conduct surveys and identify the project need of UBA adopted villages.
- Step 4: Work with Gram Panchayat & SBM-Gramin DRDA Office for implementation of IHHL, CSC & SLWM Projects
