**Preamble:** The meeting with Participating Institutes (PIs) was called by Regional Coordinating Institute SVNIT, Surat at Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Bhavan, SVNIT, Surat

**The points of discussion are as follows:**

1. Dr. K. D. Yadav (UBA Regional Coordinator) had heartily welcomed to all Participating Institutes Coordinators and Representatives.
2. Prof. Jagruti Shah from Birla Vishvakarma Maha Vidhyalaya, Anand given introduction of their completed UBA activities. They have also proposed future UBA activities, about proposal writing on subjects of 1) Physical 2) Social 3) Socio Culture and 4) Sustainable for technology development and technology customization in their respective villages.
3. Dr. Nirali Gondaliya from Shri S'ad Vidya Mandal Institute of Technology, Bharuch explained their various UBA work. They have raised their village problem regarding sewage water of village directly merged to the river Narmada and it is contaminating the river. They told their future work on rural employment.
4. Prof. Anand Kumar Singh from Government Engineering College, Daman has explained their trouble during house hold survey about Aadhar card. They have also said that in their villages there are no medical facilities available and requirement on awareness about Government Schemes. Dr. K. D. Yadav explained appropriate solutions.
5. Prof. Vijay Chaudhari from J. Z. Shah Arts & H. P. Desai Commerce College, Surat shared village problems of road facility and primary health centres. Dr. K. D. Yadav sir replied that they should meet with Road & Building Officer and Health Officer at Taluka level as well as at District level.
6. Dr. Devang Arvindbhai Shah from Parul Institute of Technology, Limda, Vaghodia, Vadodara told the problem about damage of water supply line and they will write proposal on this subject. They also raised drink addiction problem is major problem in villages and for this they will arrange awareness camps in villages.
7. Prof. Kishan Katariya from Pacific School of Engineering, Surat introduced themselves , as they joined UBA recently, they have not started any work, however for doing activities soon.
8. Mr. Sujal Dadhaniya from Charotar University of Science & Technology, Anand described their UBA activity list. They will work for computer lab facilitation in villages and make awareness among student to use dustbins and distribution of sanitary pads.
9. Ms. Boksi P. Chauhan from C K Pithawala College of Engineering and Technology, Surat has described completed UBA work in villages on water purification awareness and they will write few project proposals for villages per each department of institute.
10. Ms. Bhumika Patel from GIDC Degree Engineering College, Navasari has told about village problems like poor school infrastructure, no computer lab facility, and no awareness about government schemes. They will implement water harvesting system in villages. Er. Jaydip N. Vora replied to visit District Sarva Siksha Abhiyan office, Civil Branch and MIS branch for solving school infrastructure problems.
11. Ms. Renuka Patel from Faculty of Engg., Tech. & Research (FETR), Isroli (Afw), Bardoli, Surat has explained their village problems like, unemployment in village, and no facility for income generation for old age group also. Er. Jaydip N. Vora replied that they should visit taluka health officer and district health officer.

12. Ms. Unnati Shah from Parul Institute of Diploma Studies, Limda, Vadodara has presented their village survey and household survey work and said about village problems like, no class room facilities in village primary school. Er. Jaydip N. Vora replied to visit District Sarva Siksha Abhiyan office, Civil Branch for solving school infrastructure problems.
13. Mr. Prashantkumar B. Solanki from Government Polytechnic, Diu has told that as they have started the village survey work but students are not involving and interest in UBA activities, Dr. K. D. Yadav explained them to resolve this problem by encouraging students by keeping workshops and explaining them the advantages of UBA work.
14. Ms. Sheetal Sinkhede from Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodara given power point presentation on their UBA activities. They have been working with Vatsalya NGO and promoting Sanitary Pad Making machines among Self Help Group of villages and encourage them in women empowerment. They arrange 2-day programme "Tribal Livelihood" on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2020.
15. Dr. Krupesh A. Chuhan, UBA Coordinator from SVNIT, Surat presented various completed UBA activities in villages and share the future activities like solid waste treatment, women empowerment workshops, water management works, implementation of Government schemes.
16. Dr. Manish K. Rathod, UBA Regional Co-coordinator, SVNIT, Surat has given brief information on background of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan and explained need, vision, mission, objective of UBA. He presented the completed works and future work of Regional Coordinating Institute, SVNIT, Surat. He explained the RuTAG Products. He also suggested to all Participating Institute to do research and innovation work on real & live village problems like organic farming, energy, livelihood, water management, school education etc. and submit the solution proposals to National Coordinating Institute, IIT Delhi.
17. Er. Jaydip N. Vora, UBA Manager, RCI SVNIT, Surat explained how to Join UBA and explain the UBA Web Portal. He explained technology development and technology customization project proposal system. He also described the UBA Stakeholders, district administration and panchayat with various branches and its role. He has requested to all Participating Institute to visit and meet with District Rural Development Agency, Sarva Siksha Abhiyan, Taluka Panchayat, District Panchayat and understand the schemes running by government of India and implementation in villages with help of UBA Student teams.
18. Dr. K. D Yadav, UBA Regional Coordinator, SVNIT, Surat requested to all PIs to submit the monthly progress report within 15 days of next month so that RCI SVNIT can timely submit the Quarterly, Half Yearly and Annual work progress report to National Coordinating Institute, IIT Delhi. And requested to all PIs to develop their own UBA Website and upload it on their Institute webpage.
19. Meeting ended with thanks to all PIs.

### Common major problem:

1. All PI required the appreciation certificate format for their UBA students.
2. All PI wants a guideline for utilization of UBA fund Rs. 10,000/- per village, mail to their higher authorities Principal / Director.

### Future Action Plan for Participating Institutes

1. Provide UBA information banner at the entrance of Institute / College Gate.
2. Liaison with Gram Panchayat, Taluka Panchayat, District Panchayat, District Rural Development Agency, District Sarva Siksha Abhiyan for UBA activities and implementation of Government Schemes.
3. For motivation and encouragement of faculties, students, staff members in UBA participation, organize various campus program like swachhata, expert lectures, workshops
4. Motivate other Higher Educational Institutions in District to join UBA
5. Organize weekly meeting of UBA cell (Faculties, Students & Staff members) for UBA activities
6. Submission of Monthly Progress Report to NCI and RCI
7. Regular visit of UBA Website and RCI SVNIT Surat website


