



I wish everyone a very HAPPY NEW YEAR and great time during this convention.






#### Champs Elysees & Nanpura

Long ago, I had the fortune of visiting Paris. It was a sunny afternoon, when I decided to take a stroll on Avenue de Champs Elysees (pronounced Shawnz Elize). It was considered to be the most fashionable road on planet earth. I started from 'place de la concorde' and walked little more than 2 km to reach 'arc de triomphe', covering the entire stretch, doing window shopping, looking at menus displayed in restaurants windows, relaxing on benches provided and watching the international club class crowd carrying big shopping bags, while I sipped water from a bottle (filled at my hotel's water cooler) carefully, so that it lasts whole day. I walked under 'arc de triomphe' imagining how Napolean Bonaparte must have felt when he did the same with a platoon of his decorated soldiers.



I was tired and decided to sit and relax at the arch looking at the disciplined traffic on this historic circle with twelve radial roads. And my mind started questioning. Was it romantic. Was it worth. Am I happier after looking at this piece of history. The answer came from inside. No it was not. Another display of wealth looted from colonies. So where was happiness. It was in Nanpura Surat. I landed in Surat on 8 July 1966. A young lad of 16, raw, simpleton from Uttar Pradesh. My first abode was a hall on second floor of a building (demolished now) on Chowki Sheri, which was housing only students. There was a primary school across the road. There were five of us in that hall. Me, Anupam Mathur, Ravindra Kumar, SL Tripathi and SP Yadav. The bath and toilets were at ground floor. Nanpura's main road extended from old civil hospital up to Timaliyawad. And it was fabulous. Oh my god. There were red buses of 'Gujarat Rajya Vahan Vyawahar' traversing in both directions, and police chowki was the bus stop. We could stroll from it up to the chowk end, where there was a branch of "Devkaran Nanjee Banking company" (now called Dena Bank). I opened my life's first saving account there and always maintained a minimum balance of Rs.5/- so that I could draw cheque - a luxury. Just adjacent to that was a tea house, where beside tea, coffee one could buy and drink hot chocolate and bourn-vita. The tea came in three versions (a) Chaloo (b) Badshahi (c) Peshal (Special), beginning from 25 paise onwards. Across the road was a shop which sold paanipuri' and other gujarati savories. Little ahead was "Baroda hair cutting saloon",





where I had first shave of life. Here you could listen to endless gossip and a blaring radio. Almost every boy of SVR (it was not SVNIT then) got his hair style done there and perhaps most had their first shave too, there. Wankawala stores, which romanticized his shop as a departmental store. And indeed it was. We could buy all our needs there. Soap, tooth paste, brush, shoe polish, note books, drawing sheets and even a glass tumbler (with fancy yera designs). The owner was one Mr. Wankawala, who was always ready to help. Its competitor was Surendra store, just at bus stop. It also sold everything, but one had to stand on road, as it had no inner space, And not forgetting "Dilkhush Bakery". I had never considered it as a shop selling Nankhatai, biscuits and other bakery products - it was an institution, until Nanavati & Company opened adjacent to it and overshadowed it.. The best of bakery products, most of them unaffordable for us were kept in glass jars, and once in a while I will buy a pair of Nankhatai. My guide, mentor, room partner and friend Arun Ogale was very fond of Parle Mints. He would buy them at Surendra Store, as soon as he alighted from bus. These were small rectangles of sugar and mint and another flavor was rose. I think they came 25 paisa a packet, and a packet had ten. Ogale would promptly give me and our other partner ML Ramani two each, and consumed the rest. His appetite for Parle Mints was infinite (I have no idea whether he still likes them and whether these are available any more). Ogale was also very amused when ever he saw a big hoarding in Timaliyawad tabela for a coaching class. There was a large painted clown yelling ના પાસ થતાં પૈસા પાછા . Ogale would always narrate about that gilded promise to all and sundry.



Nanpura was also important to me, because my monthly allowance money order from father, would come to its post office, and I would go there to collect it. And then some relaxing moments in Dutch garden river front with neat Rs.150/- notes in pocket, while Tapi would carry from time immemorial, millions of cusecs of water to sea at Dumas, not far. I would feel happy, contended, relaxed and on top of the world. A feeling, of which I did not get even a delta fraction, sitting at 'arc de triomphe' on 'Champs Elysees'. Why blame Paris for it. I had transformed.

From an innocent boy to a weird, crooked, complicated person pursuing money and worldly things with hope, that it will bring happiness, peace and pleasure to me. Alas it does not. # DRISHTI A Revolutionary Concept

#### **Activity Report**

DRISHTI is the technical Hobby club of our college estblished in 2002. We conduct a number of workshops and events throughout the year and also take part various competitions like ROBOCON, CANSAT, Techfests, Innovation challenges, Boeing Aeromodelling contest etc.

During the odd semester our events are focused specially for first yearites. As the technical fest is shifted in the even semester and to give the first yearites a kick start, we organised "Grand Robo Prix". This event was a robotics event which presented two challenging statements, one was oriented towards mechanical and the other towards electronics. The event which involved participation from around three hundred first yearites was a grand success.

A series of workshops were conducted to impart basic knowledge of building a fundamental robot from scratch. Many other workshops are also conducted throughout the year such as Open Sourcing, Automobile design, basic manual robotics, basic and advance electronics, etc.

"Tech Trivia" a science and logical quiz competition, "Burj Khalifa" a structure building competition and "Automobile Design Challenge" a challenge which used everyday materials such as cardboard, paper, thermocol etc. had to be used to make an automobile were also organised exclusively for first year students.

We organised Techno-Contrivance 2.0, which invited ideas regarding the rural development. It was open for all undergraduate students of Surat city. The competition was conducted in three stages, project proposal, abstract submission and prototype presentation.

Apart from organising events DRISHTI also represents SVNIT in national competitions and do all sort of projects throughout the year. We took part in "University CANSAT challenge" which was organised first time in India and <u>stood first</u> among other 21 participants. Another innovative Idea regarding "Capacitive touch for home automation" was presented in Atmel embedded design contest organised by Atmel itself, and were <u>runners up</u> in the event. IIT Madras hosted a "Railway design challenge" where our design was among the <u>top five</u> from all the designs proposed all over the country. We also took part in ABU-ROBOCON 2016 which is a national level robotics competition. Robocon 2016's problem statement was focused on Encouragement of Renewable Energy. DRISHTI also participated in techfests, Boeing aermodelling conest, Texas Innovation challenge, Innovation for digital India-intel etc.

A number of projects are done throughout the year. Multi terrain traversing robot, stair climbing robot, LED cube and black board cleaning module were developed. A rope climbing developed by our team was used in *Ramnavmi* celebration which was used to carry the *Pushpak viman*.

Apart from these, complete assistance to first year is provided for their participation in SPARSH and techfests of various IITs.

## TERMS FOR SETTING OF UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP(S)

### Preamble:

Currently, the UG tuition fee is Rs 70,000 per year. In addition, students need about Rs 50,000 per year to cover mess, books and other expenses. Thus, the minimum cost of education at SVNIT Surat works out to about Rs 1,20,000 per year.

In view of the above costs, we recommend a minimum value of scholarship to be Rs 2,000 per month for 10 months in a year, and in multiples thereof, that is Rs 4,000 per month (Rs 40,000 per year), Rs 6,000 per month (Rs 60,000 per year), etc.

### Amount:

An endowment of twenty times the annual expenditure is considered appropriate. With the current rates of interest prevalent in the country, endowment may earn 7% - 8% interest per year. Thus, about 4% of the endowment value will go towards paying the scholarship and the balance of the interest earned will be added to the endowment to cover for inflation.

AUG scholarship per month will be generated from 4% interest of the donated amount. Minimum donation amount will be Rs. 5,00,000/-.

# **Scholarship Options:**

- The scholarship may be based on merit-cum-means or purely on merit.
- It is preferred that the scholarship be open to all students. However,
  - The donor may specify that the eligible students should come from a specific department.
  - The donor may also specify if the scholarship is meant for student(s) of a particular year.
  - o The donor may wish that the scholarship is meant for a female student. The

### General:

- Scholarship will be named after either the donor or any other person that the donor may decide.
- SVNIT will every year inform the donor about the status of the scholarship including the name of the recipient students.
- The amount is to be contributed by a Cheque / draft in favor of "SVNIT Endowment Fund". SVNIT will keep separate ledger page for each such donation. The excess interest earned (after deducting the scholarship amount) will be added to the corpus and will be used to cover drop in interest rates, inflation, and growth.
