Thanks once again and expecting more support and involvement from our alumni friends.





Channels of India like Star News, IBN-7, India T.V., aaj-Tak, Sahara India and Tej etc. had taken interviews of 100 Shankhvadak and telecasted my new concept first time in India of the Shankh Dhwani Club as well as abroad in 30 foreign countries.

For the motivation of the female technocrat students the experience story of the author is narrated here which may help to think about the career option.






