Inter-disciplinary Minor Degree in Drone Technology

CGPA, Grading, and Marksheet

1. How is CGPA calculated?

CGPA is the weighted average of the grade points earned in all courses, using the course credits as weights.

2. Will the CGPA of Inter-disciplinary Minor Degree in Drone Technology affect my main CGPA?

No. CGPA for this degree will be calculated separately like Honors.

3. Is there a separate passing criterion for CGPA?

Yes. For now, minimum requirement of CGPA for passing a course is 7 but it will be put to office of academics to bring this criterion equal to main courses.

Attendance Requirements

4. What is the minimum attendance required to appear for examinations?

Same as in B. Tech. Degree courses.

5. Does attendance affect sessional marks?

Same as in B. Tech. Degree courses.

6. Can medical or emergency absences be considered?

Same as in B. Tech. Degree courses.

7. What happens if I fail a course?

Failing a course means exit from the program. However, there will be a moderation committee looking into such matters.

8. Is there a provision for re-examination?

There are no provisions for re-examination.
